This funding will be used to


- Increase the percentage of students in Upper 2 Bands (U2B) for Reading in Year 3 to 45% and in Year 5 to 40%
- Increase the percentage of students in U2B for Numeracy in Year 3 to 28% and in Year 5 to 25%
- Identify and cater for students with learning difficulties
- Provide individualised support for students who are below National Minimum Standards (NMS)

Our initiatives include


- Providing targeted intervention programs in Literacy and Numeracy for students at risk of not meeting NMS
- Improving teacher capability through focused coaching and professional development to improve student performance
- Providing extension opportunities for U2B students in Reading and Numeracy
- Continuing to offer an intense reading program supported by teacher aide time
- Continuing to facilitate Professional Learning Communities that build data literacy of teachers and analyse student performance to identify areas of support for students

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Increasing Master Teacher fraction to full-time to provide Numeracy coaching for teachers	\$ 27 000 <i>Carried forward from 2017</i>
Providing intense whole school reading program supported by teacher aides	\$ 56 000
Providing targeted intervention programs supported by teacher aides	\$ 35 000
Providing professional development to staff in order to increase knowledge of the teaching of Reading and Numeracy - including release for Professional Learning Communities (PCL) and curriculum planning	\$ 62 000
Purchasing resources to support effective Literacy and Numeracy programs	\$ 12 000
